

**Super Spike - Foundations**  
**Level of Difficulty: Moderate**

Super spikes are generally used in situations where one end of your garden shed needs to be raised to provide a level foundation and you do not want to go through the trouble of pouring footings. In some instances, you may want to elevate the floor of your Todd's shed; super spikes enable you to do this. Before you visit your local building supply store to purchase super spikes, check your jurisdiction's building codes for rules and regulations about using them.

**A Word about Super Spikes**

- Super spikes should not be used if your area is prone to frost conditions. Typically, super spikes are used in warm climates, which do not experience frost.
- Super spikes are not included with your kit.

**What We Recommend**

When using super spikes for your shed foundation, we suggest the following (depending on the size of your structure, the recommendations below may be adjusted accordingly):

- If your garden shed is elevated, you can attach a skirt, lattice (available at your local hardware store), or stairs to hide your foundation and super spikes.
